FARCROSS project finished on a high note after 48 months of operation

The ambitious Horizon 2020 project FARCROSS, celebrated the successful conclusion of its four-year journey following the final review meeting late September 2023 in Brussels.

Over the course of the project, FARCROSS successfully achieved its demanding milestones. These accomplishments have the potential to revolutionize cross-border electricity transmission in the South-Eastern European region, and to scale up the demonstrated solutions to a larger level. This could tackle several barriers to achieve the ambitious net-zero industry target of the European Commission.

Across its 5 demo sites, the FARCROSS consortium demonstrated multiple hardware and software solutions - including modular power flow control, dynamic line rating, wide area monitoring and controlling systems and optimization tools for cross-border electricity transmission.

The project not only achieved the target numbers in the set key performance indicators, but extensively contributed to the research work on the international plane with 17 scientific publications over the 4 years.

Such achievements would not have been possible without the dedication and hard work of the participating organizations. The consortium brought together 31 partners from Greece Belgium, Bulgaria, Hungary, Austria, Romania Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Albania, Spain, Ireland, Luxembourg, Germany, Cyprus Slovenia, and United Kingdom, representing the whole value chain, from system operators, market operators, aggregators, software developers, hardware manufacturers and research institutions, universities.
